

CFC Celebrates 50 Years of Giving & Caring

The season of charitable giving, known to Postal Service and federal employees as the Combined Federal Campaign (CFC), is officially underway. This year, CFC celebrates its 50th year anniversary, hence the theme "50 Years of Caring." CFC is the largest, most successful and only authorized solicitation of Federal employees in the workplace.

With unemployment at 9%, foreclosures up 7% since February, and homelessness on a steady rise, the CFC objective of "connecting those who give with those who need" is especially urgent. "As the economy worsens, the need for givers increases," said CFC director Eriabee Chiles. "The challenge is to have those with means to think of those without. Postal Service employees have always stepped up to the plate and considered those less fortunate than they are, I don't expect they'll be any different this year."



Last year, federal employees raised more than \$281.5 million, with the Chicago District contributing \$407,708.
